**Virtual Learning after September 7th- Need to Knows**

Face-to-Face instruction on campus will resume on Tuesday September 8, 2020. For those students who will remain virtual, please read below for information on how virtual learning will continue.

1. Virtual students will continue to complete assignments **asynchronously** utilizing Google Classroom or the Summit Learning Platform(Connect students).
2. Teachers will be holding Face-to-Face classes for students on campus, therefore, teacher availability to virtual students will be at different times.
3. Students have the opportunity to meet live with their teacher during the teacher's assigned "Virtual Period." Teachers will provide students with this information.
4. Students will be counted present for attendance by engaging in the curriculum. Ex: completing assignments, turning in work, attending the teacher "Virtual Period", etc.
5. Virtual learning will align to the level of rigor students will experience in the face-to-face classroom.
6. Activities that students are assigned virtually, will also be assigned to face-to-face students.
7. Students are expected to stay on top of all assigned classwork and communicate with the teacher if they are struggling.
8. Grading policy for Virtual and F2F students will be the same. A minimum of 1 grade per week will be taken.
9. Virtual students wishing to participate in athletic teams and/or fine arts, may only come to campus before or after school for practice. Virtual students will not be on campus during the normal school hours. Transportation is not provided.
10. Virtual students coming to campus for before or after school practice, must self-screen and follow all health protocols put in place. Transportation must be provided by the parents.

Virtual students will be allowed to change to Face-to-Face instruction at the end of the grading period (6 weeks). Parents must provide 2 weeks notice of learning format change to the grade level counselors in order to level class sizes.
